


CHURCH PARKING LOTS

With the upcoming renovations at Ss. Simon and Jude Church, we offer some parking tips and advice for St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church and St. Margaret of Scotland Church. (If you missed Fr. At St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church

On-street parking is available. Please do not block driveways, and watch for no parking signs.

If using the lots on the weekend, **all lanes** can be filled. Please pull up to the car in front of you. Do not leave gaps and spaces. (Weekday visitors should not park in the lanes with arrows.)

The bell tower doors (nearest the sanctuary on the corner of 3rd Street and 3rd Avenue) cannot be used as an entrance, but may be used to exit. This is helpful for folks using the "St. Joseph" Lot, or who park in the Bagnato Funeral Home Lot.

There are a limited number of spaces behind the church on Barrett Way. You may use the exit door in the middle of the church after Mass to access these spaces. DO NOT enter through that door. It is locked. Do not knock on the door to obtain entrance. You must walk around the building.

At St. Margaret of Scotland Church

We have room for two rows of cars going up the driveway. DO NOT start a second row and leave an empty space against the curb. If you can't parallel park in the empty space, move on. (An example of this is circled in red on the picture).

As a courtesy, able-bodied folks should leave the level parking near the school for those who may have difficulty walking up the driveway to the other lots.

Please pay attention to the signage! Do not block traffic by parking behind the school improperly. Do not park in the clergy spaces.

If using the Fleet Street Lot, please use caution when crossing the street.
